### **Youth Purpose Statement**

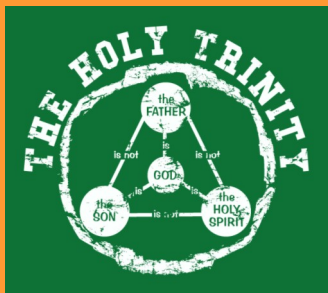

The Mission Planning Team is excited to announce two opportunities for you to serve during the summer of 2017. A team of adults and youth (7th-12th grades) will travel to David, KY, from **June 4—9, 2017** to participate in a Vacation Bible School for the community and work projects around the David School. The cost for this mission is \$350, with a nonrefundable deposit of \$100 and a completed application. Space is full for the David Mission but contact Raleigh to be put on a wait list.


Adults and youth (9th-12th grades) will travel to the Dominican Republic from **June 17—25, 2017** to serve through work projects and VBS in the communities of Samangola and San Rafael. The cost for this mission is \$1,000 with a nonrefundable deposit of \$300.
