*People:* Thanks be to God.

*Reader says: Psalm 8 will be read responsively by whole verse.*

**Reader O Lord our Governor, how exalted is your Name in all the world!**

People Out of the mouths of infants and children your majesty is praised above the heavens.

**Reader You have set up a stronghold against your adversaries, to quell the enemy and the avenger.**

People When I consider your heavens, the work of your fingers, the moon and the stars you have set in their courses,

**Reader What is man that you should be mindful of him? the son of man that you should seek him out?**

People You have made him but little lower than the angels; you adorn him with glory and honor;

**Reader You give him mastery over the works of your hands; you put all things under his feet:**

People All sheep and oxen, even the wild beasts of the field,

**Reader The birds of the air, the fish of the sea, and whatsoever walks in the paths of the sea.**

People O Lord our Governor, how exalted is your Name in all the world!
