2 Corinthians 13:11-13

Reader says: **A reading from Paul's second letter to the Corinthians**

Finally, brothers and sisters, farewell. Put things in order, listen to my appeal, agree with one another, live in peace; and the God of love and peace will be with you. Greet one another with a holy kiss. All the saints greet you. The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, the love of God, and the communion of the Holy Spirit be with all of you.

Reader: **The Word of the Lord.**

People: Thanks be to God.

Pause, then read the Psalm.

Reader says: Psalm 8 will be read responsively by whole verse.

Reader O Lord our Governor, how exalted is your Name in all the world!

People Out of the mouths of infants and children your majesty is praised above the heavens.

Reader You have set up a stronghold against your adversaries, to quell the enemy and the avenger.

People When I consider your heavens, the work of your fingers, the moon and the stars you have set in their courses,

Reader What is man that you should be mindful of him? the son of man that you should seek him out?

People You have made him but little lower than the angels; you adorn him with glory and honor;

Reader You give him mastery over the works of your hands; you put all things under his feet:

People All sheep and oxen, even the wild beasts of the field,

Reader The birds of the air, the fish of the sea, and whatsoever walks in the paths of the sea.

People O Lord our Governor, how exalted is your Name in all the world!
