

Things to Know About Tuesday Bible Study

What if I'm late?

We will start promptly at 9:30 a.m., so please make every effort to be on time. We know emergencies happen. Come as soon as you can.

Why is there a fee for the study?

The optional \$10 fee is for TBS materials and copying.

What do I need to bring to class?

You will need to bring a Bible and a pen or pencil each week for taking notes.

Where can I get the weekly discussion questions?

They will be available online one week prior to each lecture at www.stfrancisinthefields.org/ministries/tuesday-bible-study or you can pick up a copy at the back table in Graves Hall.

What if I can't come to all the sessions?

You are always welcome. Try to let your small group leader (if you participate in a small group) know when you will not be there. Also, the discussion questions and a recording of the lecture can be accessed on the website.

Can I invite someone to start the class after the session begins?

Yes, but we do ask all participants to register the first time they attend. Be sure that your friend arrives early (9:15 a.m.) to fill out the registration form.

What if I have never studied the Bible before?

You are not alone! You will feel very comfortable. Listen and learn from others and share only when you are ready.

What if I can't complete the course?

Try to block out this time for every Tuesday. Make it a priority and come as often as you can.
